The Commencement Ceremony will be held on **Thursday, June 11th**, at 10:00 am on the John B. LaPorta Theater lawn. In the event of inclement weather, the ceremony will be held indoors in the gymnasium. Any changes related to the weather will be communicated via email.

CAPS & GOWNS / TICKETS

- Will be passed out to Seniors on Friday, June 5th
- Please try on your gown and make sure it fits. If it doesn't, go to the Guidance Office to have it exchanged.
- Caps may be decorated, but they **MUST** be tasteful and appropriate. Inappropriate decorations on caps will not be allowed.
- All students will receive **4 tickets for the indoor ceremony**. The outdoor ceremony will not need tickets.

GRADUATION PRACTICE

Practice will be held on Wednesday, June 10th at 9:30 am. All graduates **MUST ATTEND** practice.

COMMENCEMENT DAY

A light breakfast will be served on the morning of the Commencement in the Cafeteria, starting at 8:45 am. Seniors are invited to spend some time with their classmates and get ready for the ceremony.

Graduates who do not attend breakfast **must arrive at school no later than 9:30 am**. All graduates should go directly to the cafeteria for staging. Graduates must bring their caps, gowns, and shop cords with them to the cafeteria. Students will be organized by career shop and lined up alphabetically in the staging area.

Students who are graduating or volunteering to assist with commencement should attend on June 11th. Any students who are not participating in commencement do not need to attend school on June 11th.
